## Angel Falls

*The highlight of any trip to Venezuela is Angel Falls. Known in Venezuela as Salto Angel, it cascades 3185 feet from Auyun Tepui, a towering sandstone plateau. The falls were named for pilot Jimmy Angel, who crash-landed atop the tepui in the 1930's.*

### ANGKOR WAT, CAMBODIA

the Khmer civilization. From 800 A. D. to 1430 A. D. the Khmer peoples built a series of walled and moated capitol cities

Robert was free to wander throughout the Archeological Park with his 4" x 5" camera.
